The North Carolina Parenting Education Network offers a professional Parenting Educator Credential.

Depending on your qualifications, you can be credentialed one of four levels of a credential.

The credential recognizes your experience plus your credit and non-credit education devoted to supporting parents and their quest to raise successful children.

Benefits:

- Noting your credential on employment applications and resumes as a mark of professionalism and achievement
- Being recognized as a Parenting Educator when presenting evidence-based curriculum
- Feeling personal satisfaction with your professional achievement
- Being voluntarily listed in a statewide directory of parenting educators
- College students can apply for a credential even prior to graduation as a mark of what you know and to qualify you for part time and full time positions
- Organizations and agencies can report the number of parenting educators who are part of the professional staff (in grant proposals, in program reviews and to executive boards)

Become part of a growing movement. North Carolina is leading the way. Other states are examining our system. Plans are to revise the current system in the future. Be part of the present system.

There is a \$40 application processing fee. After receiving your packet, a panel of Credentialed Parenting Educators will review the applications and you will receive notification within 3 months about the status of your application.
